To Members and Visitors of United Lutheran Church:

As many of you know, last night our Crisis Ministry Team convened last night for a considerable length of time in order to deliberate on the matter of when to resume public worship and other group gatherings at United Lutheran Church.

After much prayerful deliberation which involved a consideration of:

- Synodical and Local government guidelines and recommendations,
- the most recent statistics involving the state of COVID-19 spread in our community,
- the projected point in time with regard to COVID-19 “peak,”
- the timelines of other congregations within the Lincoln area,
- a thorough checklist of precautions of what will change at United with regard to our assemblies when worship and gatherings resume,

we have tentatively set the date to resume public worship at United Lutheran as Sunday, May 31.

United Lutheran’s Church Council will revisit plans and proposed assembly guidelines at their next meeting, May 11 at 6PM. More information will be published after this meeting.

Please know that, amid this profound disruption of our plans, that our priority in these coming months is to make United Lutheran’s assemblies as safe and as comfortable as is possible. Everything else will be determined in light of this priority.
